A good prepared CV and a genuine letter will be enough for application but before that they should decide whether the center is suitable for their expectations. For example our center gave us a clinical approach but I dont recommend anyone who couldnt speak or understand German fluently to visit that center because their discussions about patients were all in German and also we were not be able to do a research project because of language barrier I was upset that I couldnt understand and speak German fluently.
